Bryan O'Sullivan

Displayed in projects from yachts to private jets, apartments to hotels, Bryan O'Sullivan's talent defies categorization — and boundaries. He credits his maternal grandfather with sowing the seeds of his future career. "He was a master builder and self-taught designer who specialized in the restoration of churches," recalls the London-based architect and designer who, at 36, is a rising international star. In a New York apartment high above Fifth Avenue, he combined bespoke and antique pieces to create cozy spaces that look curated over time. Here, a pair of Jorge Zalsupin chairs complement a walnut bed by Annabelle Selldorf, while the 1937 Venini mirror and Roberto Rida table lamps add relaxed glamour.
